can't happen again. There was an earlier recall in  
the spring for the same thing, but it was still a  
problem after that.

Jan Magnussen turned the quickest time in the GT1 class at 3:49.406 in the No. 63 Compuware Corvette C6.R, with Oliver Gavin a heartbeat behind at 3:50.766 in the No. 64 Compuware Corvette C6.R. Qualifying will continue with a second four-hour session today to set the starting grid for the 76th running of the world's most revered sports car race. However, rain showers are predicted for tomorrow. Practice and qualifying for the 24 Hours of Le Mans will conclude tonight with two timed sessions from 7-9 p.m. and 10 p.m. to midnight.

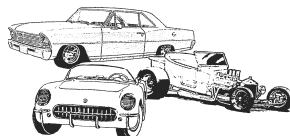
