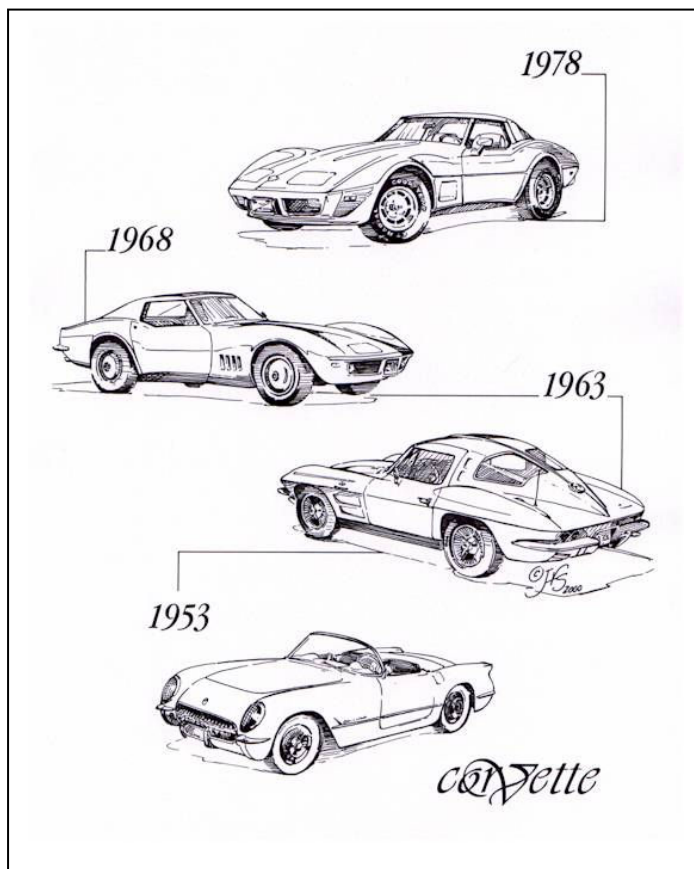

We all had a great meal and enjoyed the social discussions revolving around our cars and the planned summer events. Thank you to the hearty bunch who braved the weather and participated in this annual ritual. Next year it will be WNYCC’s turn to plan the event.

We have a couple of events planned for the rest of May and then the club’s summer schedule kicks in. Please review the schedule of events and participate in as many as you can. The folks organizing these events put in a lot of effort and their only reward is seeing heavy club participation – if only a handful show up, they wonder whether it is worth putting in this effort. 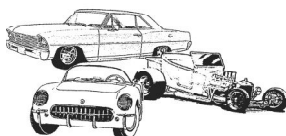
